



No Heat Checklist

- Are all of the windows closed?
- Are my heat vents covered by curtains or furniture that are restricting the heat flow?
- Have I checked with my heating services provider to make sure they didn't disconnect them for some reason?
- Is my furnace filter plugged? It's a good idea to check your filter every month. On average your filter should be changed every 3 months or sooner if needed.
- Have I turned up my thermostat higher than the temperature the room is sitting at?
- Is the "FAN" switch on? (this can look like a light switch located somewhere near the furnace if you have one. When turned off this turns off the fan to the furnace so no air will be blowing through the floor vents)
- I've checked all of the items above but still have no heat! Call your landlord if you rent or your local plumbing and heating contractor.
